Policy Directives and Commitments:

1. The Company will not procure raw materials from natural forest areas, protected areas, or locations at risk of deforestation.
2. Promote the procurement of natural rubber from sources certified under recognized sustainability standards, such as FSC, PEFC, or equivalent.
3. Support conservation agriculture practices, including agroforestry, intercropping, and integrated farming systems.
4. Utilize resources efficiently, reduce waste, control pollution emissions, and adopt clean
5. technologies within production processes.
6. Promote the restoration of natural ecosystems and the conservation of wildlife habitats through active collaboration with local communities and external partners.
7. Promote the use of environmentally certified raw materials (e.g., FSC, PEFC, GAP) or raw materials sourced without forest encroachment, ensuring full supply chain traceability in compliance with the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR).
8. Develop a robust raw material traceability system to ensure transparent and verifiable sourcing across the supply chain.
9. Regularly disclose environmental metrics, biodiversity conservation data, and progress on policy implementation to the public.
